

College of Engineering Distinguished Faculty Fellow

While successful (full) professors are recognized as Distinguished Teaching/Research Professors, Regents Professors, or Chair Professors, many successful assistant and associate professors also deserve recognition. The CENG Distinguished Faculty Fellow initiative targets rising star tenure and tenure track assistant and associate professors.

Each department chair in consultation with faculty can nominate one or more candidates to the Dean's office based on: (1) Scholarly activities and (2) Competitive Research expenditure. Based on the recommendation from the College Executive Committee, the Dean will make the final decision.

The nomination package should include CV of the candidate. A faculty member can receive the award only once and hold the title for two years or until promotion to full professor. The award carries \$5,000 discretionary fund each year for two years jointly provided department and college. Nominations are due to the Dean's office March 3.
