

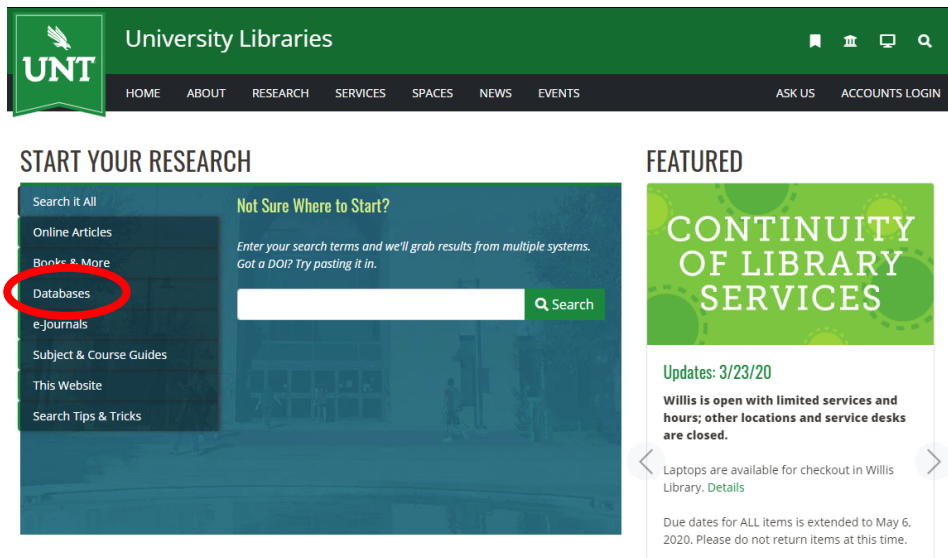
**Purpose:** Accessing digital research databases from off-campus

**Procedure:**

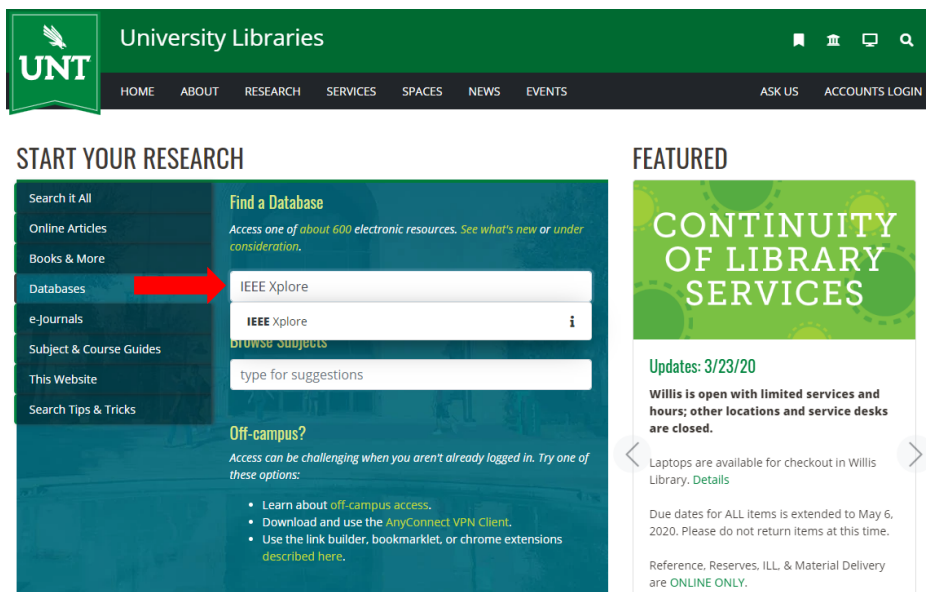
To access digital library databases (IEEE Explore, ACM Digital Library, etc.), visit <https://library.unt.edu/>

On the main page, select the 'Databases' tab

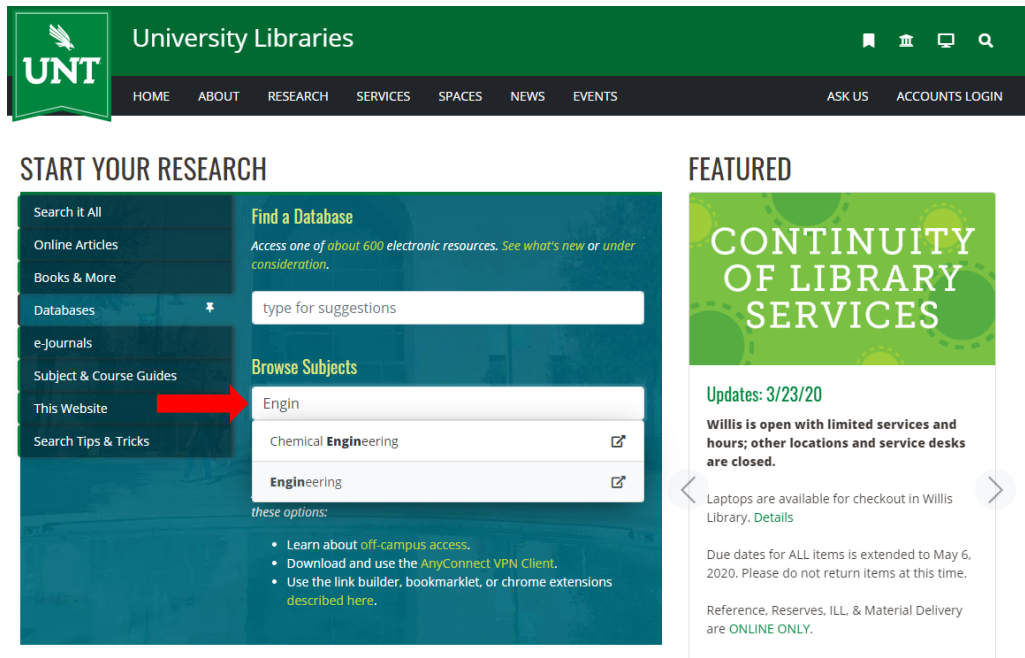


Once on the databases page you have several options:

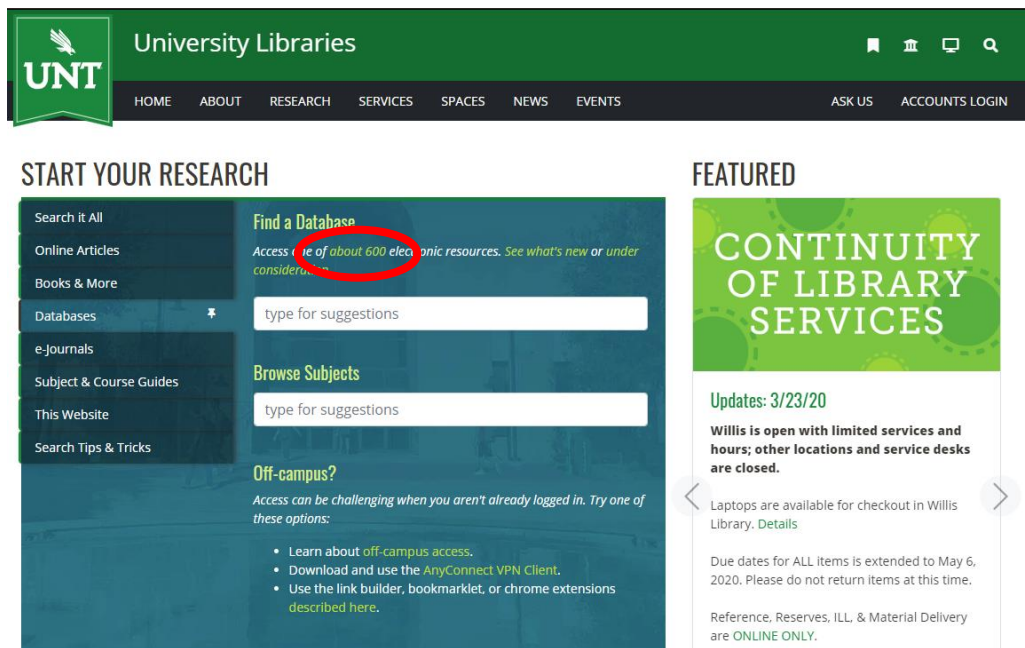
- Search for the name of a database (if known) in the first search box. (i.e. IEEE Xplore)



- Use the 'Browse Subjects' search box to search for all databases related to a field of study (i.e. Engineering)



- Or if you prefer, you can click 'about 600', shown in the image below, to be taken to a listing of all available digital databases



If viewing the entire databases list, a search can be done for the database or it can be found alphabetically.

**IBISWorld**  
**Alternative Name(s) & Keywords:** IBIS World  
IBISWorld is a collection of U.S. and global industry market research and U.S. risk ratings. It contains business reports in five categories including industry market research, industry risk ratings, and company research for the U.S., global industry research, and selected economic and demographic data. Market analysis components include overviews, industry performance and outlook, competitive and regulatory environment, major competitors, operational conditions, and key statistics. U.S. risk reports discuss industry and market risk, including industry life cycle, growth potential, and economic sensitivity. Downloadable report elements include SWOT analyses, statistical tables, and graphs.

**ICPSR**  
An international consortium of more than 700 academic institutions and research organizations, ICPSR maintains a data archive of more than 500,000 files of research in the social sciences. It hosts 16 specialized collections of data in education, aging, criminal justice, substance abuse, terrorism, and other fields.

**IEEE Xplore**  
Full text access to IEEE Journals, Transactions, Magazines, Letters, Conference Proceedings, Standards (current only), and IEE Journals and Conferences. Dates of Coverage: 1988 to current, with some journals and conference titles available from 1950.

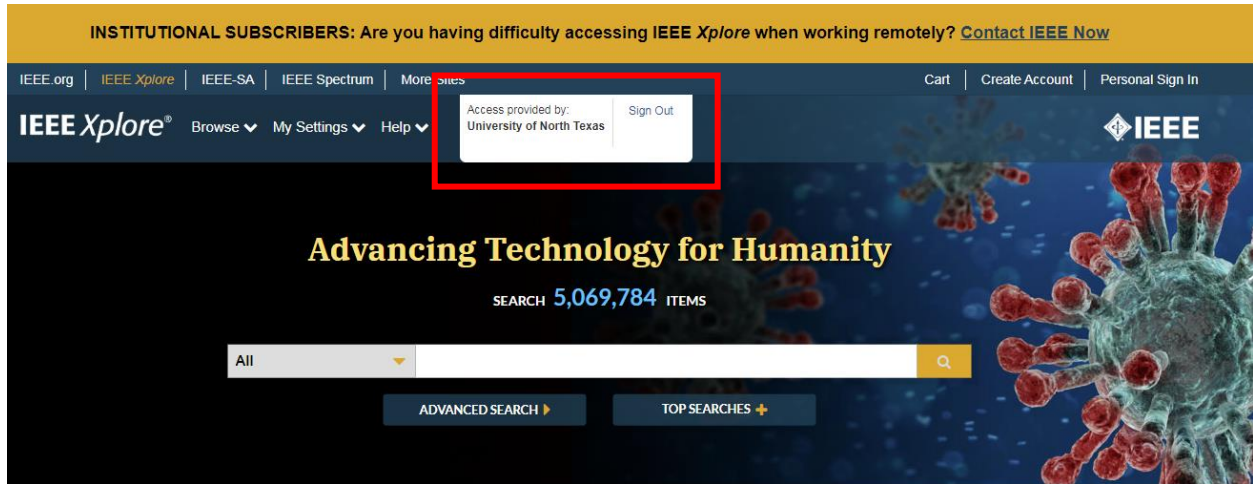
