

CENG International Graduate Collaborative Academic Agreement Process

Any faculty member can initiate the process by following [UNT Collaborative Academic Agreement Guide](#). This document specifically defines the details of the CENG approval process of Collaborative Academic Agreement.

1. A faculty member submits the draft agreement, answers to benchmark questions in the [UNT guide](#), as well as the degree requirements of the international institution to the graduate coordinator of their department.
2. The department Graduate Committee evaluates the agreement and provides feedback. The agreement is modified based on the feedback.
3. The Graduate Committee provides recommendations to Department Chair who rejects or signs off on the agreement.
4. The Department forwards the agreement package to the College Graduate Committee Chair.
5. The College Graduate Committee evaluates the agreement and provides comments to the Dean for final decision.
6. The Dean makes a decision and forwards the package to UNT-I.
