CENG International Graduate Collaborative Academic Agreement Process

Any faculty member can initiate the process by following <u>UNT Collaborative Academic Agreement Guide</u>. This document specifically defines the details of the CENG approval process of Collaborative Academic Agreement.

- 1. A faculty member submits the draft agreement, answers to benchmark questions in the <u>UNT guide</u>, as well as the degree requirements of the international institution to the graduate coordinator of their department.
- 2. The department Graduate Committee evaluates the agreement and provides feedback. The agreement is modified based on the feedback.
- 3. The Graduate Committee provides recommendations to Department Chair who rejects or signs off on the agreement.
- 4. The Department forwards the agreement package to the College Graduate Committee Chair.
- 5. The College Graduate Committee evaluates the agreement and provides comments to the Dean for final decision.
- 6. The Dean makes a decision and forwards the package to UNT-I.
